What is this place like?

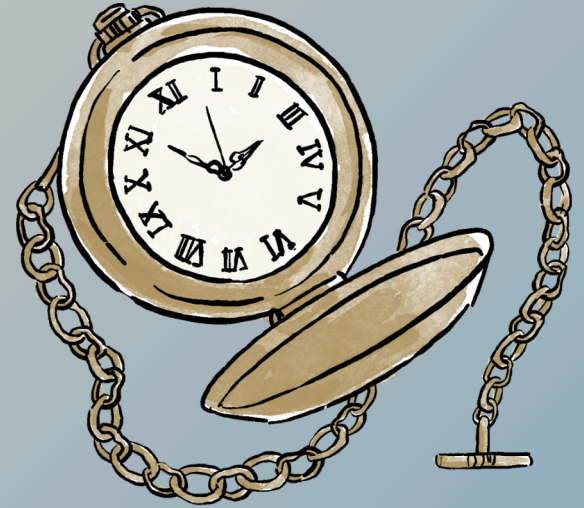
