The Minnesota Humanities Center is pleased to offer a limited number of private Bdote trips from late April through mid-October for groups that are seeking an experience to enhance their work by learning from those who have the longest history to this land, the Dakota people.

The cost for a private Bdote trip is \$5800. For organizations that move forward with scheduling a Bdote trip, MHC will draft a contract. A deposit of \$1800 will be made upon signing the contract; the remaining \$4000 will be due within two weeks following the experience.

BDOTE TRIPS INCLUDE:

- Up to 50 participants for a six-hour day, typically from 8:30am–2:30pm. A shorter customized route can be arranged, although the cost remains the same.
- Two Dakota community scholars throughout the day.
- Dakota singing and drumming.
- A tour guide audio system is used throughout the day to enhance hearing accessibility and an opportunity for participants to listen in solitude while overlooking Bdote.
- A follow up email to be shared with participants that includes multiple resources to extend the learning.
- A report of participant survey responses and complimentary action plan consultation.
- Unlimited admission to Beyond Bdote virtual workshop.

Transportation and lunch are not included; however, we are happy to suggest options.
